

Hendricks County Business Community

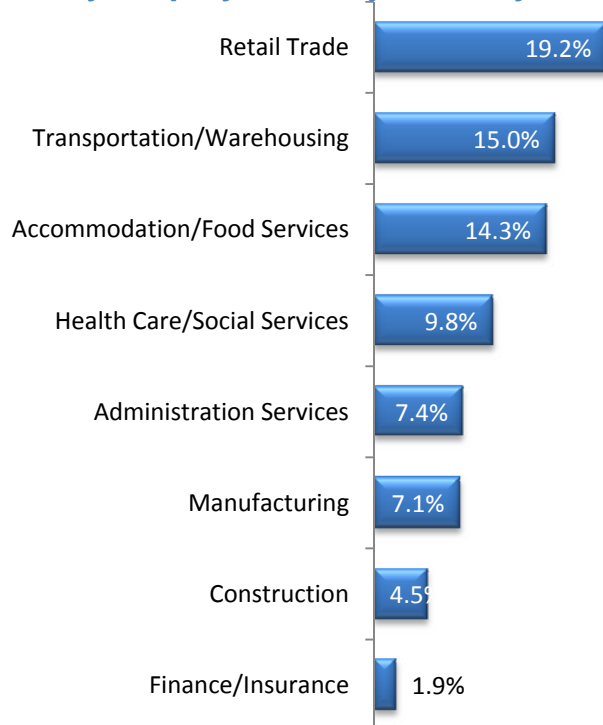
