

# Morgan County DEMOGRAPHICS

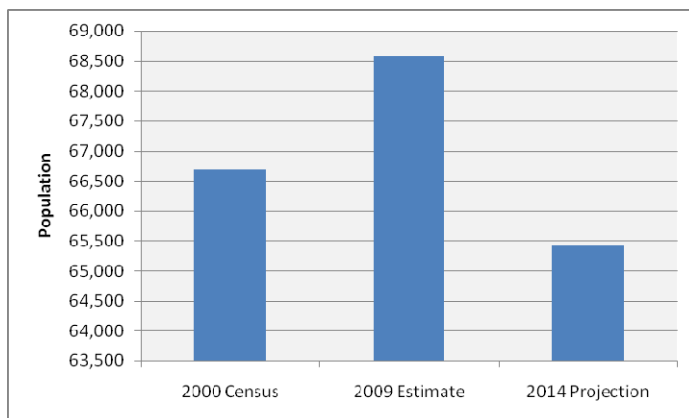
