Smart IT Staffing, Inc.

July 2010 - Smart IT Staffing Inc., an information technology firm, announced plans to expand its Indianapolis headquarters, creating up to 80 new jobs by 2014. The company, which provides contract staffing and full-time placement services for companies needing information technology workers, will invest more than \$480,000 to lease and equip additional space at its current downtown Indianapolis headquarters.

The Indiana Economic Development Corporation offered Smart IT Staffing Inc. up to \$1 million in performance-based tax credits based on the company's job-creation plans. The city of Indianapolis will consider additional property tax abatement at the request of Develop Indy.

Miller Consulting Group

June 2010 - Technology services firm, Miller Consulting Group, announced they will expand operations in Noblesville, creating up to 230 new jobs by the end of 2013. The company, which provides computer-aided design and engineering services for the aerospace, defense and medical device industries, plans to invest \$2.1 million in computer software, hardware and equipment.

The Indiana Economic Development Corporation offered Miller Consulting up to \$2.5 million in performance-based tax credits and up to \$120,000 in training grants based on the company's job creation plans. The city of Noblesville will consider additional property tax abatement.

GEMMS, Inc.

April 2010 - Health information technology company, GEMMS, Inc. announced it will expand its operations in Carmel, creating up to 69 new jobs by 2015. The developer of electronic medical record systems for cardiology practices plans to invest up to \$2.1 million to grow its headquarters and software development operations.

The Indiana Economic Development Corporation offered GEMMS, Inc. up to \$1 million in performance-based tax credits and \$52,000 in training grants based on the company's job creation plans. The city of Carmel will provide additional property tax abatement.

BlueLock LLC

March 2010 - BlueLock LLC, a provider of cloud computing and managed information technology services, announced it will expand its Indianapolis headquarters operations, creating 118 new jobs by 2014.



BlueLock LLC, will invest more than \$35.6 million to make improvements and upgrade hardware at its 20,000 square-foot data center. City planners have recommended approval of a 10-year tax abatement for BlueLock tied to the project.

Exacq Technologies, Inc.

March 2010 - Video management systems developer, Exacq Technologies, Inc. announced plans to expand its headquarters in Fishers, creating up to 49 new jobs by 2013. The technology developer plans to invest \$1.1 million to lease additional space at its current 10,000 sq. ft. facility.

The Indiana Economic Development Corporation offered Exacq Technologies, Inc. up to \$650,000 in performance-based tax credits and up to \$7,500 in training grants based on the company's job creation plans. The town of Fishers will consider additional property tax abatement.

BC Forward (formerly Bucher + Christian)

December 2009 - Indianapolis technology consulting firm BC Forward is expanding its headquarters and creating 200 jobs by 2012. The company, previously known as Bucher + Christian, is planning to invest nearly \$2 million in the project and lease additional space in downtown Indianapolis. BC Forward says the new positions will pay an average of \$63 per hour.

The Indiana Economic Development Corporation offered BC Forward up to \$2.65 million in performance-based tax credits and up to \$67,500 in training grants based on the company's job creation plans. The city of Indianapolis will provide additional property tax abatement at the request of Indianapolis Economic Development, Inc.

The 10-county Indianapolis Region includes Boone, Hamilton, Hancock, Hendricks, Johnson, Madison, Marion, Monroe, Morgan and Shelby counties.
