Sock maker For Bare Feet finds new home in Martinsville

MARTINSVILLE, Ind. -- A manufacturer of socks for professional sports teams and colleges announced plans Thursday to lease a vacant Martinsville factory to replace one burned in a Brown County fire.

For Bare Feet, or FBF, will move into the former Harman-Becker Automotive plant, a campus of 225,000 square feet of offices and manufacturing space on a 24-acre site.

Founder and chief executive Sharon Rivenbark said the plan is to resume production of the custom-designed socks and other knit merchandise by early November. ...
