

Hamilton County DEMOGRAPHICS

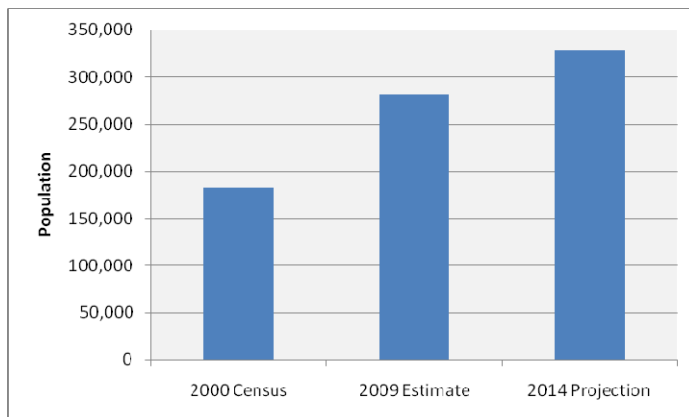


Hamilton County is ranked in the top 20 in the U.S. for quality of life according to Forbes.com, and the town of Fishers and city of Carmel were both ranked among the top 15 Best Places to Live by Money Magazine in 2010. 54% of residents have a higher education degree. Hamilton County, a financial and high-tech center, is home to Conseco and one of the three regional EnerDel locations, a developer of lithium-ion batteries for hybrid vehicles. Hamilton County is part of the Indianapolis Region, which is home to almost 2 million people and 1 million skilled workers.
