

# City of Indianapolis/Marion County DEMOGRAPHICS



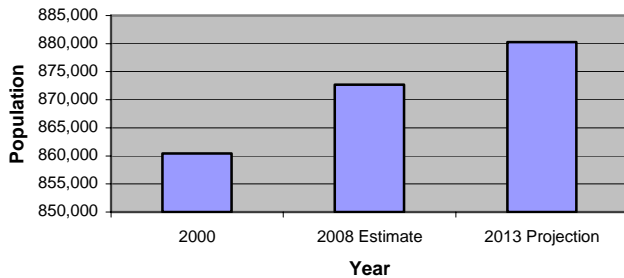
