

# Morgan County DEMOGRAPHICS



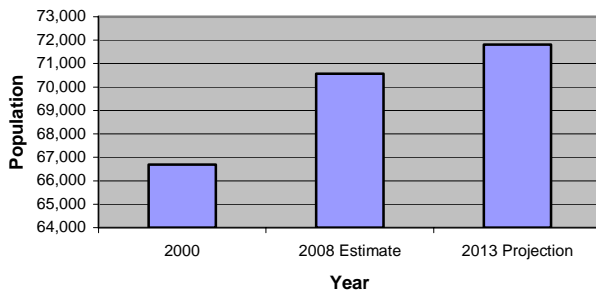
